You can create your own will in less than an hour by using Lucet's interactive Will Maker. **Here's how:**

- 1. Log onto willprep.lucethealth.com using code MML.
- 2. Click on **Personal Documents**. Choose the appropriate document. Note: To protect your privacy, registration is required. All documents come with complete instructions. You can also start a document and save it online to update it later.

The online wills are valid for residents in all 50 states. As with any legal matter, you may want to consult with an attorney to discuss your options and to make sure the family is fully protected, especially if you have questions or concerns.
